**Please note that a 3% discount on the annual tuition will be applied if you enroll into an automatic payment plan.**

**New student application fee: \$25 (non-refundable)**

**REGISTRATION FEES (due upon completion of enrollment packet):**

**K-6<sup>th</sup> grades:** March 5-15: \$105; March 16-31: \$135; After March 31st: \$185

**7th-12th grades:** March 5-15: \$165; March 16-31: \$195; After March 31st: \$245

- Current student registration starts March 5<sup>th</sup>.
- New student registration starts March 16<sup>th</sup>.
- The registration fee is non-refundable.

Insurance fee: \$50/student (billed to your account and due July 1st)

Facility fee: \$150/family (billed to your account and due July 1<sup>st</sup>)

**ELEMENTARY STUDENTS (Grades K-6):**

**ACADEMY OF ARTS AND HISTORY: Meets Thursdays, AM & PM sessions available – 28 weeks**

*One room schoolhouse approach studying Art, History, Music & Theatre, plus Gym/PE in a historical framework*

Tuition: 1<sup>st</sup> student: \$795; 2<sup>nd</sup> Student: \$760\*; 3<sup>rd</sup>+ Student: \$725\*

\*This multi-child credit will be applied to your account.

**PREPARATORY: Meets Wednesdays – 30 weeks**

**Lower Elementary (Grades K-4):**

Smartstart: Tuition - \$995

*One room schoolhouse approach studying History, Math, Science & Language Arts.*

STEAM: Tuition - \$360

**Upper Elementary (Grades 4-6):** Tuition - \$360/class; Literature/Writing - \$465 (1.5 hour class)

*Students can select a la carte classes in Math, Science, History, Literature & STEAM*

**ELEMENTARY STUDENTS (Grades K-6) CONTINUED:**

**ARTIOS PLUS: Meets Mondays – 28 weeks**

*Classes consist of choir, dance, & art and drama clubs*

Tuition: \$360/class

- Student must be enrolled in either the Academy of Arts & History or Preparatory to participate. If not enrolled in the Academy, then a minimum of two Preparatory classes must be selected. SmartStart satisfies the 2 class minimum requirement.

**MIDDLE SCHOOL STUDENTS (Grades 7-8):**

**CONSERVATORY MS (7<sup>th</sup>-8<sup>th</sup> grades): Meets Mondays – 28 weeks**

*Students can select courses in the disciplines of Music, Art and Theater to better prepare them for more advanced courses when they reach High School.*

Core class Tuition (Art, Music, Theatre, Worldview): \$275/class\*

\*If all four core MS classes are enrolled in, a \$200 credit will be credited to your account.

Worldview is a required class for all MS students

Tuition: Choreography, art club - \$360; Choir, drama club - \$395

**PREPARATORY: Meets Wednesdays – 30 weeks**

*Students can select a la carte classes: Pre-Algebra, Physical Science, History, Literature & STEAM*

Tuition: \$490/class

- Worldview is a required class for all MS students.
- Must select a minimum of two classes within Conservatory MS & Preparatory combined in addition to Worldview.

## **HIGH SCHOOL STUDENTS (Grades 9-12):**

### **CONSERVATORY: Meets Mondays – 28 weeks**

*Students can select beginning to advanced courses in the disciplines of Music, Visual Art, Theatre, Graphic Design & Dance.*

Tuition: \$490/class except for Worldview - \$395; Vocal Ensembles - \$345

### **PREPARATORY: Meets Wednesdays – 30 weeks**

*Students can select from the following courses: Anatomy, Biology, Chemistry, Physical Science, Algebra I, Geometry, Government & Economics, History, Literature, Writing & Mechanics, Spanish I and Life & Study Skills. (Algebra II may be offered if the student's and school schedule allows.)*

Tuition: \$490/class

- Worldview is a required class for all HS students.
- A minimum of two Conservatory and/or Preparatory classes is required in addition to Worldview.

### **ARTIOS STUDIOS (PRIVATE and SEMI PRIVATE INSTRUCTION):**

*Disciplines include: Art, Dance, Guitar, Piano, Strings and Voice. Includes 26 weeks of instruction and an end of year recital with additional possible performance opportunities throughout the year.*

Private 30-minute lessons: \$725

Private 60-minute lessons: \$1,450

Group lessons: \$540

- Coaching fees for competition may apply

### **ADDITIONAL FEES (PERFORMANCE CLASSES):**

Choreography (all): Costume Fee- approx. \$100 per event (billed to parents during school year)

Chorale Sr (Guys): Must purchase a tuxedo plus annual accessories (ties, vest, etc) – approx. \$100

Chorale Sr (Girls): Dress rental fee- approx. \$40 (billed to parents during school year)

Must participate in Fundraising program (Choir, Choreography & Drama Club): \$400/student; \$1,000 max/family

Competition fees (BJU & CITA): \$85-\$300 depending on competition and events participating in
